Happy New Year! 2024 was a very busy and exciting year at Eagle Crest Communities. We started the year with a major 1.2-million-dollar remodeling project at our Cass Street Assisted Living community. Cass Street was the original nursing home when Bethany Lutheran Homes originated 78 years ago. Over the years, two additions were added to Cass. In 1983, Cass was converted into assisted living when our Riverside Transitional Care nursing home was built.



Cass Street Assisted Living is located in the heart of La Crosse's Historic Housing District. The beautiful homes that line the streets tell the story of a rich history of wealth from lumber barons, button factories, rock quarries, brewery companies,

and others who built magnificent homes along Cass Street.

Cass Street has always been a beautiful facility, but it was time to update it with modern lighting, colors, furniture, and décor. We also reconfigured some areas to give it an open look. New flooring, lighting, paint, and furnishings throughout the entire community make it look like a new home. We also replaced the parking lot and added a new drive-through canopy to help protect our residents from the weather when coming and going.

An interesting fact about this project – while excavating the parking lot to replace it, we found the parking lot was built over the top of a filled-in home foundation. The foundation extended all the way to the existing building. That wasn't something we were expecting, and it took about a month for it to be excavated and refilled. That might explain why we have had so many issues with the parking lot breaking up over the years.

In October, we broke ground on our Eagle Crest North expansion. The addition will be connected to our existing Eagle Crest North community with 87 new apartment homes. Our new addition will offer beautiful views and a wonderful carefree lifestyle. The new addition will offer many more amenities, including a golf simulator, large botanical garden with 180-degree views, game room, club lounge, large grocery area, woodworking shop, and fitness center, just to name a few. This will add to all the amenities currently offered at Eagle Crest North. When it opens in January 2026, we will have a larger community with more social interaction and amenities for everyone to enjoy.

The Home That Love Built


